THE THING



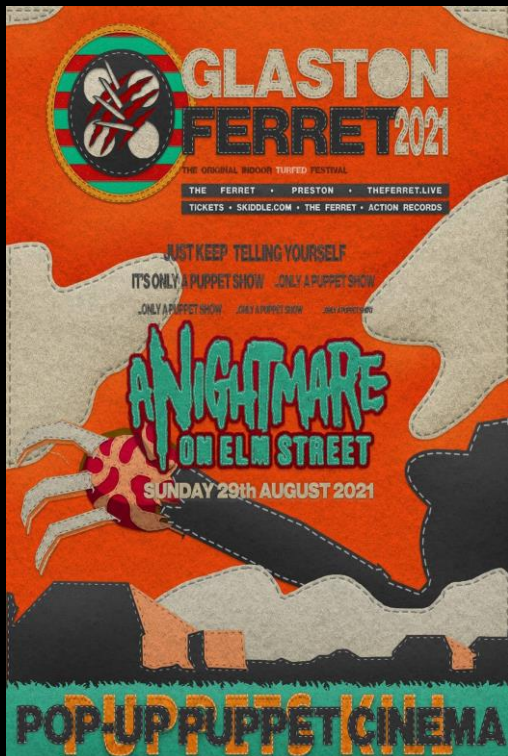
In the desolate frozen wastes of the arctic lies Outpost 31. The men stationed there are preparing for a long, hard winter.

How long are the shows?

Each performance lasts between 20 and 30 minutes, after which the puppeteers will invite audience members to inspect and take selfies with the puppets.

Is Pop-up Puppet Cinema suitable for kids?

Whilst you might think that a puppet show is children's entertainment, our shows aim towards a slightly different demographic; those 'grown up kids' who spent their youth watching The Muppets and their favourite Spielberg or horror movies.

That not to say that children don't enjoy our shows!

We do always advise any parents that some of the jokes in our shows, while never overt and will certainly fly over the heads of the young audience members, might not be considered appropriate by some.



How many shows can I book

We usually advise that 1-2 shows is best, depending on the event, but we're open to suggestions!



TECHNICAL REQUIREMENTS

Stage requirements: Our puppet stand combined with banners spans approximately 4 metres wide by 2 metres deep - please ensure you have this much space for our performance.

Sound System: Pop-up Puppet Cinema requires a professional sound system suitable for live performances, a single microphone and mini-jack lead accessible from the stage.

Stage Lighting: Appropriate stage lighting. Lighting cues are not essential but can contribute to an engaging performance, if your venue has a lighting engineer, please let us know!

Dressing Room Facilities: A secure and comfortable space for puppeteers to prepare and build the show, puppets and props.

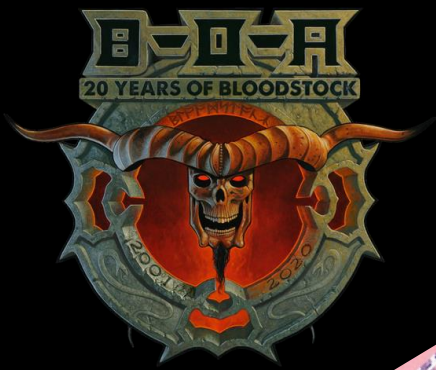
